E.ON Makes Power Plant Deployment Transparent

Starting today, anyone can find out how much electricity each of E.ON Kraftwerke's German power plant units can generate at any given point in time. The power stations' expected 12-month availability will be published a year ahead. Unpredictable deviations, occasioned e.g. by technical faults, will be published within than 30 minutes. In addition, one can gain a retrospective overview of the amounts of electricity actually generated by each power plant unit.

This transparency will primarily benefit power traders and purchasers as well as consumers. The host of additional information on the generation market's supply side will enable more precise market analyses and price forecasts. This will promote competition. Furthermore, regulators will have an easier time of verifying that E.ON Energie's power plants are deployed to meet market requirements.

Says Bernhard Fischer, Executive Vice President Technology at E.ON Energie: "E.ON is the first company on the European Continent to disclose this depth and detail of data on its in-house production. In so doing, we are providing more important stimulus for increased competition in Germany and Europe. We hope that a great many power producers will follow suit."
